For an enhanced spa experience, additional masks featuring algae, minerals, or lava can be purchased to further nourish and rejuvenate your skin.

Continue to Lake Mývatn, known for its unique pseudo craters formed by steam explosions rather than eruptions. • Walk through the mystical lava formations of Dimmuborgir, often linked to Icelandic folklore, and explore the geothermal area at Námaskarð, with its bubbling mud pools and steaming vents. After a day immersed in volcanic landscapes and natural beauty, return to Akureyri with unforgettable memories.
